

REGULATIONS & RECOMMENDATIONS

France Sclérose en Plaques Foundation welcomes any basic and clinical research applications focused on Multiple Sclerosis, including for example: immunologic basis of MS, myelin biology, axonal degeneration, restoration of myelin and axonal integrity, susceptibility to MS, epidemiology, virology, infectious disease processes that may trigger disease activity, imaging technology, identification and use of surrogate markers, clinical research and therapeutics, and so on.

IMPORTANT DATES

- March 31: deadline for the online submission
- > 1st Tuesday of July and the following Wednesday: selection of the projects
- > August: publication of the final list of laureates
- August to October: signature of the agreements
- > From November: Start of the contracts

ELIGIBILITY

For research grants:

- Research projects taking place outside of France can be funded by Fondation France Sclérose En Plaques provided they are integrated in a multicenter project, including at least one French team with a major role in the project.
- 2. A principal investigator (PI) can only submit one project to the Fondation France Sclérose en Plaques **BUT** he/she can be a collaborator in another submitted project.
- 3. Funding will be granted for one year.
- 4. A principal investigator (PI) can submit a project every year (no limitation on the number of vears).
- 5. Funding is for laboratory expenses, equipment, access to a technology platform... Funding for a technician or paramedical staff can be requested, but the amount for the salary cannot exceed 1/3 of the total requested amount.
 - The budget must not be used for indirect costs or overhead costs (defined as costs associated with Institution's ongoing operating expenses such as facilities and basic utilities, the purchase and repair of office equipment, administration fees, etc.).
- 6. Candidature to another research call should be clearly indicated and the links between the projects explained
- 7. A fixed amount will be awarded: 50 000 € maximum per project.

For fellowships:

- 1. France Sclérose En Plaques support covers salary (38 000 € for a PhD fellowship; 60 000 € for a postdoctoral fellowship)
- 2. The support is for 1 year
- 3. The candidate to a fellowship cannot be granted for more than 3 years



- 4. The candidate should be less than 40 years old on March 31.
- 5. French nationality is not required
- 6. It is not possible to combine France Sclérose en Plaques fellowship with the fellowship of another structure.
- 7. A principal investigator (PI) can only submit one project as a coordinator for grant or for fellowship

PhD students can apply for fellowships only for their last thesis year (3rd or 4th year) and only if

- 1. The PhD student is a student in a French university.
- 2. The absence of funding for the entire PhD work (3 years) is clearly justified
- 3. A 4th year is necessary for the completion of the PhD and is authorized by the French University. A letter from the University is requested.
 - → Complete the file "Fellowship" and only this one.

Note: a special attention will be given to PhD students.

Postdoctoral researchers can apply for fellowships only under the following situations:

- the postdoctoral training is carried out in a different laboratory from the PhD lab.
 However, a "junction fellowship" may be granted for a period of one year (non-renewable)
 to complete the project initiated during the PhD fellowship in the same lab. This request
 must be clearly justified.
- 2. the applicant resides in France: funding can be granted for the first year and possibly renewed,
- 3. the applicant applies for a foreign laboratory: funding can be granted only for the first year providing that the PhD has been performed in France
 - → You can complete both files "Fellowship" or "Grant + fellowship".

REMINDER: In respect with the French law, the duration of fixed-term contracts in public laboratories cannot exceed 6 consecutive years (for postdoctoral fellowship). If you have already completed 5 years, a letter from the employment institute is requested.

NOTE: The fellowship granted by France Sclérose en Plaques Foundation in "YEAR N" will have to start before February 1st "YEAR N+1"

EVALUATION

Scientific excellence is the sole criterion on the basis of which grants, and fellowships are awarded

Selection of the projects is based on the project originality, feasibility, the relevance to multiple sclerosis and associated disorders, the pertinence and the relevance of the methodology, the



quality of the management (ability of the applicant to manage the project and a team), and benefit for people with MS or related disease.

HOW TO APPLY?

France Sclérose En Plaques proposes 3 types of research supports

- 1- "Application for **fellowship**" to fund a doctoral or post-doctoral candidate in studies related to MS or associated disorders.
- 2- "Application for research grant" to fund a project,
- 3- "Application for research **grant + fellowship**" to support a project **AND** a post-doctoral fellow for **working on this project**. Beware! If you ask for a grant and a fellowship associated to the grant, you must send ONLY this file.
 - → If you ask for a last year's thesis, you CANNOT apply for an associated grant.

Application procedure

The project file can be loaded from the France Sclérose En Plaques Foundation website: https://www.arsep.org/fr/220-calls-for-proposals.html

Online submission: https://www.arsep.org/fr/220-calls-for-proposals.html no later than **MARCH** 31. The application form on the website must be completed by the principal investigator (coordinator).

NOTE: before completing the information on the website, please read with attention "Guidelines on how to complete the online applications".

The project file should be signed by the PI. For collaborators, please use the document "Signature of collaborators" and attach it with the project file or send it by email to scientific@francesep.org.

No extensions on the deadline will be permitted and no proposals will be considered after this date. Any non-compliant or incomplete (unsigned version, missing or non-conforming parts, etc.) will be considered inadmissible.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Applications must be written in English. More than 2/3 of the reviews are sent to experts outside of France.
- Indicate 2 to 3 names of expected reviewers BUT Any researcher or clinician having collaborated with a participant of the project within the 5 years preceding this request should be excluded
- Do not forget to specify your abbreviations
- For clinical studies: pay attention to your control groups, the number of individuals and justify your statistics, numbers, ...
- Travel or meetings expenses must be limited.
- The budget is for laboratory expenses and must not be used for indirect costs or overhead
 costs (defined as costs associated with Institution's ongoing operating expenses such as
 facilities and basic utilities, the purchase and repair of office equipment, administration
 fees, etc. see section 5.3. of the internal regulations of FRANCE SCLÉROSE EN PLAQUES
 Foundation).



France Sclérose en Plaques foundation cannot manage the funding granted. A
partnership agreement will be signed between the foundation and your managing
institute. Beware: agreements can only be signed between France Sclérose En Plaques
Foundation and public research institutes
