

Create a **new independent or autonomous team** on Multiple Sclerosis or associated disorders

REGULATIONS & RECOMMENDATIONS

The 'EMERGENCE' call for research proposals is intended to support, over a **period of 3 years** a **young researcher** (CR/DR Inserm or CNRS or other French Institution), teacher in a French University (MCU/PU), clinician-scientist (MCU-PH/PU-PH), French or not, **wishing to set up** in France **a new independent or autonomous group** to develop an original clinical or fundamental research project on MS or associated disorders.

The allocated budget will support the creation and development of the research group, as operating credits, small equipment and / or contract salaries.

The allocated budget will be 150 k € per year for 3 years.

NOTE: This call for creating a young team will take place every 2 years (alternating with the creation of a national network)

IMPORTANT DATES

- > 2025, March 31: deadline for the online submission
- 2025, July 1st & July 2nd: selection of the project(s) by the France Sclérose en Plaques Scientific Committee
- July: possibility of interview(s) of pre-selected applicant(s)
- > August 2025: publication of the decision
- From November 2025: Start of the contracts

ELIGIBILITY

- The call is open to scientists of any nationality who may reside in any country in the world at the time of application, but
- The project must be developed within a French research structure, supported by a University and / or a Public Research Entity (INSERM, CNRS, University, CEA, INRA, ...)
- The applicant must hold a permanent position in France (INSERM, CNRS, University, CEA, INRA, ...)
- > The applicant will carry out his/her project as leader of a **new independent team** in a French research structure or **new autonomous group attached to a recognized team** in a French research structure. The **host laboratory** will provide a letter of support and will confirm that the young team/group will get a **dedicated lab space**.
- Any present or previous mentors (of PhD / post doc fellowship, team leader) should not be a member of the applicant's team/group
- Any application from a laureate of an ERC or Impulscience program will not be eligible
- Applicants must have defended their MD or PhD for more than 2 years and less than 12 years when submitting the project (i.e. on March 31, 2025). For maternity, an additional period of 18 months will be granted for each child before or after the MD/PhD award.



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EVALUATION PROCESS

Scientific excellence is the sole criterion on the basis of which EMERGENCE grants are awarded. Selection of the projects is based on the project originality, feasibility, the pertinence and the relevance of the methodology and the quality of the management (ability of the applicant to manage the project and a team)

HOW TO APPLY?

Application procedure

The project file can be loaded from the France Sclérose en Plaques Foundation website: https://www.arsep.org/fr/220-calls-for-proposals.html

Online submission: https://www.arsep.org/fr/220-calls-for-proposals.html no later than MARCH 31, 2025. The application form on the website must be completed by the principal investigator (coordinator).

NOTE: before completing the information on the website, please read with attention "Guidelines on how to complete the online applications".

The project file should be signed by the PI. For collaborators, please use the document "Signature of collaborators" and attach it with the project file or send it by email to scientific@francesep.org.

No extension of the deadline will be permitted, and no proposals will be considered after this date. Any non-compliant or incomplete application will be considered not eligible.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Applications must be written in English. More than 80% of the projects are sent to reviewers outside of France.
- Do not forget to specify your abbreviations
- Regarding a new research group / team, please clearly indicate the composition of the group / team (including FTE numbers) and the originality of the research project in the context of the host laboratory.
- For clinical studies, please pay attention to your control groups, the number of individuals, justification of statistics, numbers, ...
- Travel or meetings expenses must be limited.
- The budget is for laboratory expenses and salary. It cannot be used for indirect costs or overhead costs (defined as costs associated with Institution's ongoing operating expenses such as facilities and basic utilities, purchase and repair of office equipment, administration fees, etc.).



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The project file and all related documents must be written in English
